- ✓ Your child's current teacher and the **VSP** teacher will work together to assure that students transition well to the **VSP**. Students will use Google Classroom during virtual instruction.
- ✓ **VSP** teachers will use and adhere to all EBR curriculum and instruction guidelines.

General Student Expectations:

- ✓ Following expectations will result in praise and rewards.
- ✓ Failure to follow behavior expectations will result in consequences and/or interventions.

Additional Information:

- ✓ Malfunctioning devices and equipment should be returned to the school.
- ✓ **VSP** recommends that a family transitions back to home school at grading intervals only.
- ✓ The **VSP** guidance counselor and Ms. Tate will work together when a family transitions back into the regular school setting.
